## SKATING & SKILL DEVELOPMENT (SSD) PROGRAM

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*Program Fee: \$595 per skater for all levels*

The SSD program has been created to concentrate on improving the skills needed at each age specific level of hockey. This intense training program will include two on ice sessions per week with level directors and on-ice instructors to maximize development, reinforce proper technique, & correct form deficiencies. This will be combined with skating agility and edge work along with small area games and professionally run practices.

In order to provide the most enhanced and competitive development, players will tryout and be split into two groups appropriate to their level of play. This program is for the dedicated athlete who desires to play at the highest level.

Our Bantam and Midget coaching staff will be involved in all on ice and off ice checking clinics. Note: Per NIHL rules, attendees receive credit for the checking clinic ONLY if they attend 2 full sessions. Players can attend all (3) days if their schedules permit.
